

PGHS Homecoming Parade Details

Date: October 28, 2017

Start Point: Barber Avenue Park

End Point: Penns Grove High School Stadium

Arrival Time for Line Up: Between 9:30 am and 9:45 am

Parade Start: 10:00 am

Approximate End Time: Between 10:45 am and 11:00 am

Route: Start at Barber Avenue Park; Parade down Main Street and Harding Highway to S. DuPont Road; Continue on DuPont to the Back Entrance of the High School

Busing: Buses will arrive at the High School at 8:30 am; Truck Drivers will depart for Pointe to pick up the trucks at 8:30 am; Band will depart at 9:00 am; Cheerleaders will depart at 9:15 am; Participants who meet at the High School will depart between 9:30 am and 9:45 am; Trucks will loop back to Barber Avenue Park at the Conclusion of the Parade as well

Pointe Buick GMC of Penns Grove/Carneys Point: Pointe will be loaning us 5 brand new pickup trucks that will safely sit 6 occupants for the Homecoming Court (2), the BOE & Administration (2), and the PG Mayor & PG Council Members. The CP Mayor & Committeeman will secure their own truck.

The students will be recognized over the loudspeaker. To conclude the parade festivities the Band and Cheerleaders will perform the "We on Fire" song.
