2017-2018 STANDARDIZED TESTING INFORMATION

Assessment Descriptions:

Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers PARCC is administered for English Language Arts and Mathematics to grades 3 through High School, and it is required by both the State of New Jersey and the Federal Government. All Students enrolled in Algebra I, Algebra II and Geometry class must take the PARCC assessment. (Testing times will range between 60 minutes and 110 minutes, depending on the grade and subject.)

New Jersey Student Learning Assessment Science (NJSLA-S) is a mandated assessment for grades 5, 8, and 11. (Testing administration will be approximately 2 hours for elementary, 3 hours for middle school, and 4 hours for high school.)

Dynamic Learning Maps are administered to selected Special Needs Students. Please contact your child's Case Manager, for questions and concerns.

WIDA Access 2.0 is a mandated State and Federal Assessment administered to students enrolled in the English as a Second Language (ESL) program. (Testing time is based on student ability.)

High School Portfolio Assessments are designed for high school seniors, who require additional instruction to meet graduation requirements. The Portfolios must be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Education, in order to receive credit for the Portfolios.

National Assessment of Educational Progress is a national assessment administered in selected grades; it is designed to measure student progress in English Language Arts and Mathematics. Districts are randomly selected to participate in the assessment, if selected the assessment is mandated.
