




## To login to Wireless Internet on Your Chromebook:

### Connect your Chromebook to Wi-Fi

To connect to the Internet, use a compatible Wi-Fi network.

#### Step 1: Turn on Wi-Fi

1. At the bottom right, select the time.
2. Select Not Connected .


Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.

3. Turn on Wi-Fi.
4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.

#### Step 2: Pick a network and connect

1. Select the secure Wi-Fi network .
2. Type the network password.
3. Select Connect.

Your School-Issued HotSpot will contain the name '**ALCATEL Linkzone**' followed by a four-digit number. Your password to your School-Issued HotSpot will be the last eight digits of your HotSpot's IMEI that is printed on the bottom of the box you received with your HotSpot, as shown below:
