PERSONAL ACHIEVEMENT HALL OF FAME
GUIDELINES

The Hall of Fame was begun to honor individuals who have been successful in business, professional career, self employment, or have shown exemplary community or humanitarian service. The following guidelines were adopted for the selection of candidates for the Personal Achievement Hall of Fame.

CRITERIA

1. A nominee must have graduated from Penns Grove High School and be an alumnus for a minimum of five years.
2. A nominee must have been at Penns Grove High School for three years between 9th to 12th.
3. Upon leaving Penns Grove High School, an individual must be successful in business, professional career, self employment, or exemplary community or humanitarian service.
4. There will be a maximum of six (6) individuals selected for induction for the first three (3) years and a maximum of three (3) inductees thereafter.
5. Nominations can be made by anyone who feels an individual is worthy of the honor.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee will be made up of:

- High School Principal, Chairperson
- 3 Members of the Faculty
- 4 Community Members
- 1 Other (media, administration, board member, etc.)

VOTING/SELECTION PROCESS

1. The committee will screen all applications and each committee member will select individual/s he/she feels should be honored.
2. The applications selected will then be voted on by the committee.
3. Each committee member will review the nominees and vote on a point system. Each member will vote for each nominee by giving a 3 to their first choice, a 2 to their second choice, and a 1 to their third choice. All points will be totaled. To be selected an applicant must receive 75% of the total points voted.

OTHER INFORMATION

1. All applications for nomination will be available in the Principal's Office and must be returned for consideration.
2. The individual/s chosen will be honored at the Academic Awards Dinner each year.
3. All applications for candidates not selected will be reviewed for consideration for a period of five years.
4. All data and final selections will be submitted to the Superintendent of Schools.
